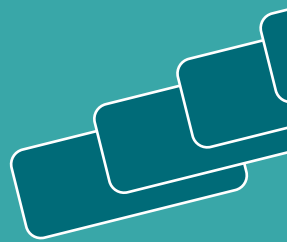

04	Back up controller, drive, network and configuration data before replacement, migration or firmware work.
05	Verify every companion module, cable, connector, termination and power source from approved drawings.
06	Do not copy electrical, communication, mechanical or lifecycle values from a related model or successor.
