Place the rack and affected protection functions in the approved maintenance state.

Verify the selected position is intentionally unused in the current configuration.
- 4

Inspect the 130944-01 front panel and 128031-01 I/O cover before installation.

Connection and Installation Sequence

INSTALLATION PRINCIPLE

Verify 130768-01 against the 3500/05 rack service record before installation. Preserve the associated rack hardware, alignment and fastening arrangement, then inspect the completed assembly before modules are returned to service.

Protect the backplane and keep conductive debris away from the rack.
- 2

Use the documented cover fasteners without substituting unrelated hardware.
- 3

Confirm both front and rear access openings are correctly closed.
- 4

Restore the rack and verify no new module or communication diagnostics are present.
